# Overview of Issue

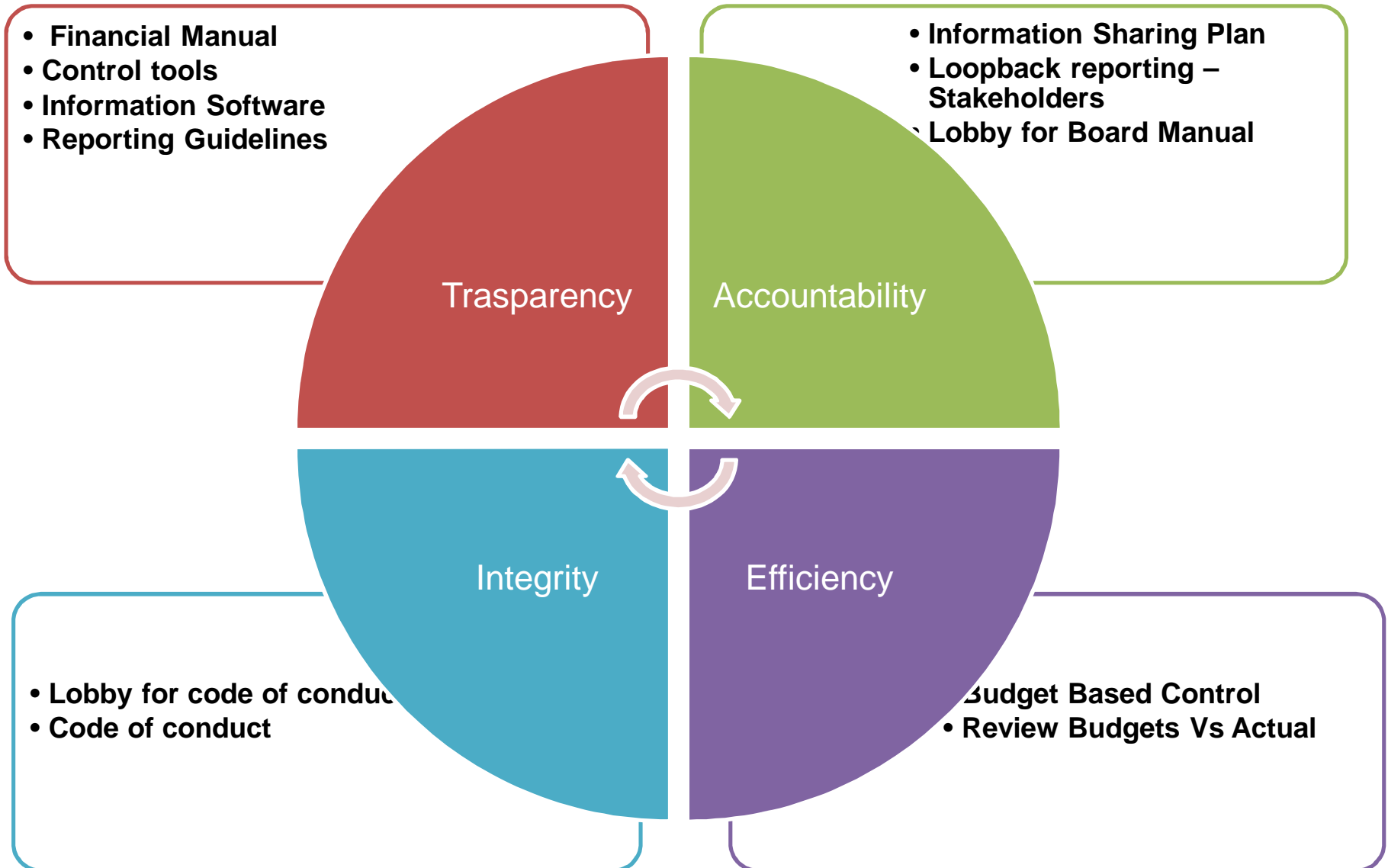
